Para iniciar a aula para seus alunos



Abra o "Plano de aula", clique em 'Ensinar' e selecione 'Na frente da turma' e simplesmente compartilhe sua tela.



Depois de iniciar, o cartão da aula exibe o nome do plano de ensino e sua descrição.



Clique em 'VAMOS LÁ!' para começar. O rastreador de missões é exibido à direita para mostrar seu progresso e a estrutura da aula. Clique em qualquer coisa que 'balance' na tela.



Os cartões de tarefas guiam você, passo a passo, pela aula. Eles irão aparecer na parte inferior da tela e podem ser fechados com o 'X' para ver e explorar o globo da Lyfta. A tarefa atual está destacada a vermelho; basta clicar no ícone vermelho para reabrir um cartão de tarefa.

Para avançar na aula, você deve completar cada cartão de tarefa antes de passar para o seguinte. Use os botões na parte inferior de cada cartão de tarefa para concluir a tarefa e abrir automaticamente a seguinte.

Quando você terminar de ensinar a aula, basta fechar a guia para retornar à interface do professor. Clique em 'Terminar aula' no canto superior direito para terminar a aula.
